CHILD CARE is available in the gated School area.

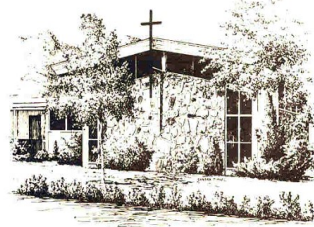

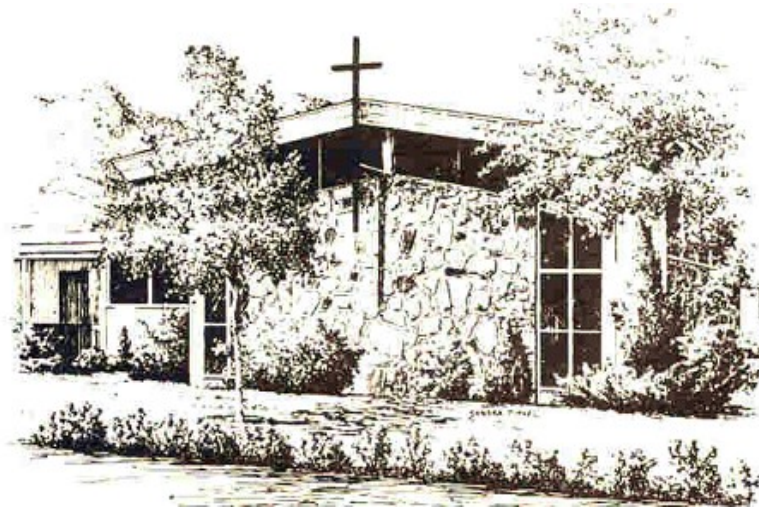
